1. Introduction and Need

The CIF is to establish a health and safety benchmarking database, which would comprise of a web-based toolkit, allowing for interrogation of data on Accidents/Incidents.

Exact statistics for health and safety performance of the construction industry have always been difficult to ascertain. We have all found ourselves looking at some trend in our own figures, whether they be actual accidents or near misses or even inspection trends and we are not sure what they indicate for want of a larger population to compare to.

A previous attempt to establish a database ended in 2010 coincident with the overall industry slowdown and the same health and safety logic for having it exists. One of the concerns of this approach is the exposure of individual businesses statistics, but this will be a recording database and not a reporting one. Our obligations for legislative reporting will not change with this. The quarterly reports would be an industry record and not a series of individual business outputs.

Benefits of such a data base should include:

- Positive acknowledgement for contributors
- Self-generated figures are more reliable
- Our individual figures will not be in a vacuum
- We are doing most of the work anyway
- Greater opportunity to improve including better data for research
- Information in a timely manner
- Avoid that bad injury or fatality on your site.



2. Information you will need to participate in the Initiative

People at Risk - The Average no of People on your Project and Office Sites per Day, split into

- Own Employees
- Sub-Contractors
- Visitors

Information that is available through your internal sign in protocols

Incidents – A record of ALL your H&S Incidents be it:

- Accidents
 - o Type of Injury
 - o Injured Body Part
- Dangerous Occurrence
- Near Misses

For the **Individual** associated with each of the type Incidents listed above, what is their:

- Gender
- Age
- Employment Status

For ALL Accidents and Dangerous Occurrences, we also need to record the:

- Triggers as per the ROI Health and Safety Authority definitions
- Associated Lost Time of Work

Activating your Account

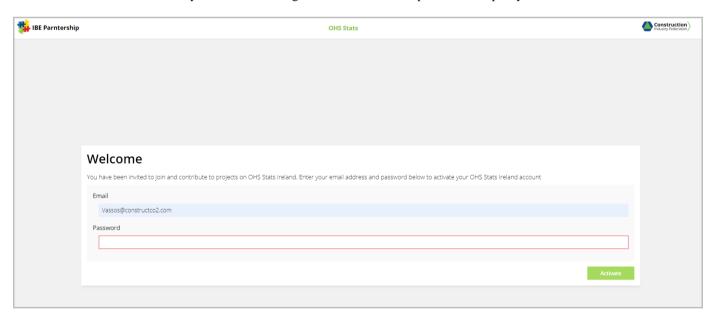
The IBE Facilitation Team (*contact details in the last section of this Guide*) will add you as a User of the Database on request. They will need your:

- Company Name
- Your Name and
- Your Email

Once add into the system you will receive an automatic e-mail inviting you to join as shown below.



Click on the Link. This will take you to the Front Page of the toolkit to complete the set-up of your user account as instructed.



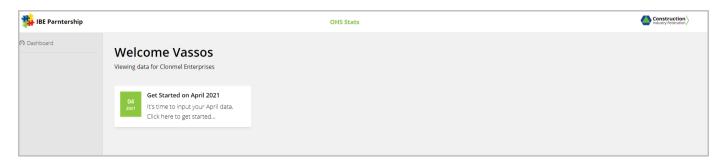

Once you typed your Username and Password the system will take you into your own Company's Home Page and you will see the screen shown in below:

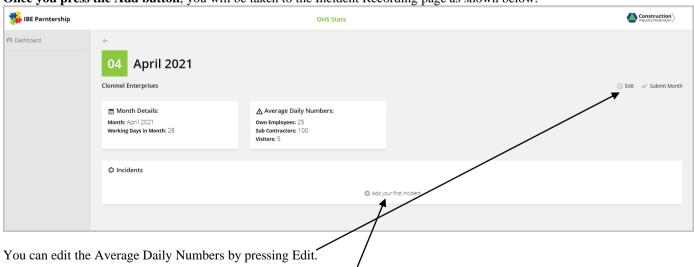


Your own Home Page will show the current month that data is needed (in this case April 2021) as well as any that have already been completed.

Once you click on the Month, then you need to add the current month's no. of days and the Average Daily nos. for Own Employees, Sub-contractors and Visitors as shown below:

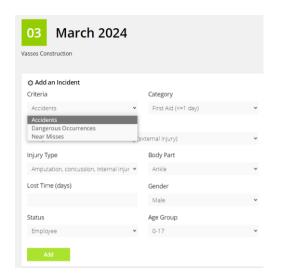


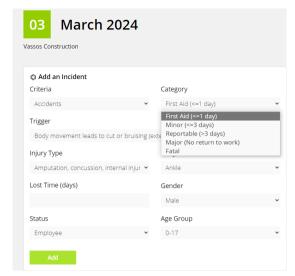
Once you press the Add button, you will be taken to the Incident Recording page as shown below.



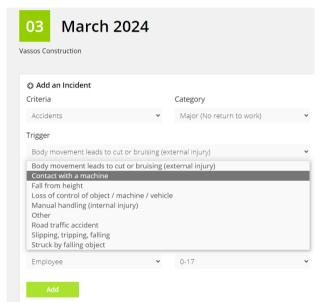
Start adding your monthly incident by pressing Add your first incident.

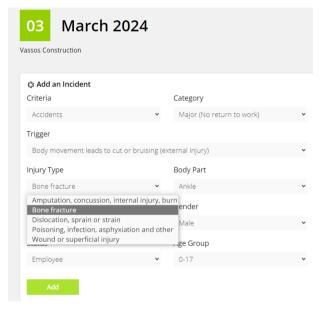
Start by choosing what Type of Incident it is from the pull-down menu. Then the Category of Accident



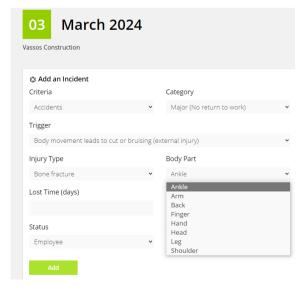


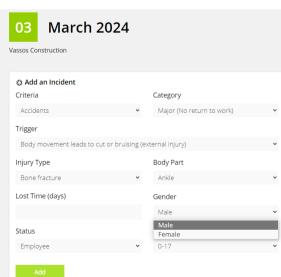
The Trigger for the Accident, |Record in any Lost Time (days) of work and the Injury Type





The injured Body Part, Lost Days of work and their Gender

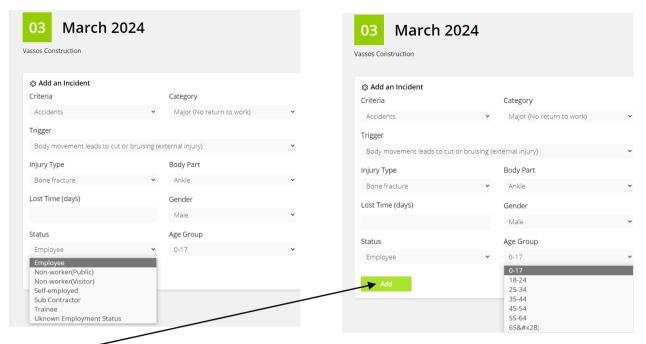




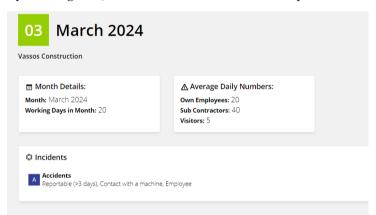


Their Employment Status,

By **Pressing Add**, the incident will be saved into the system as shown below:



You can **Edit a saved Incident** by clicking on it or the **Edit** button and You can **Add ALL** your monthly Incidents by pressing the **Add** button and repeat the process.



Once you have added ALL your Monthly Incidents you can Submit them to the Database by pressing Submit Month.

<u>Please note:</u> Submitting will prevent further editing of data for the month and cannot be edited unless you request a reactivation from the Facilitation Team.
